# **SCHOLARSHIPS 2010**



**N**ext spring Eau Claire Energy Cooperative will award up to \$9,500 in higher education scholarships to students of member families through the Federated Youth Foundation Scholarship Program. Eighteen different \$500 scholarships will be awarded to high school students, home-schooled students, as well as current CVTC and UW-Eau Claire students.

**Application Deadline**

**To qualify, the applying student must fit the following criteria:**

- Be a member of Eau Claire Energy Cooperative and currently receive electric service at their primary residence.
- Display average or above-average academic records.
- Display potential to successfully continue achievement in a post-secondary public or private college, university, junior college or vocational school program of choice that will lead to an associate degree or one-year diploma or bachelors degree.
- Be accepted into the school where the scholarship will be used.
- Display unusual financial requirements or special circumstances.

All applications must be completed and returned to the high school, technical college, or university student office on or before **January 29, 2010**.
