**\$5 monthly credit
June, July, August, September**

I agree to comply with the rules and regulations of Eau Claire Energy Cooperative and I understand any willful violation of the usage constraints will automatically cancel my application and the Central Air Conditioning credit will no longer be available to me. In the event that tampering is found, any credit given since the last inspection will be billed back to me.

WHAT IS CENTRAL AIR CONDITIONING

“LOAD MANAGEMENT”?

The central air conditioner at your home may be shut off during peak periods of electrical demand via a radio signal emitted from Dairyland Power Cooperative in La Crosse, Wisconsin. During those peak periods, your air conditioner may be cycled, 15 minutes on – 15 minutes off, in an effort to lower electrical demand. The load management equipment installed is not a time clock and control does not occur on a daily basis, only during peak demand periods.

- There is no charge for the “Load Management” hardware.
- A \$5.00 credit will be applied during the months of June, July, August and September, when energy usage is 400 kWhs or higher. No credit will be issued when usage during the months indicated falls below 400 kWhs. This credit is reviewed annually.
- The credit begins after the load management equipment is installed. Eau Claire Energy Cooperative guarantees installation within 90 days.

Availability

Available under established rules and regulations for service to central air conditioners of Cooperative members subject to the following criteria:

Criteria:

- (a) The air conditioner must be a central system and not a window unit, wall unit, or mini-split system
- (b) Usage pattern must be such that the load can be cycled, 15 minutes on – 15 minutes off, during peak demand periods.
- (c) Cooperative personnel will be given access to the load management equipment for maintenance and inspection purposes.
- (d) A monthly credit will be paid during the billing months of June, July, August and September, when energy usage is 400 kWhs or higher.
- (e) Necessary load management equipment will be installed and maintained by a representative of the Cooperative.
