CONTROLLED CENTRAL AIR CONDITIONING

Availability

Available under established rules and regulations for service to central air conditioners of Cooperative members subject to the following criteria:

Criteria:

- (a) The air conditioner must be a central system and not a window or wall unit.
- (b) Usage pattern must be such that the load can be cycled, 15 minutes on – 15 minutes off, during peak demand periods.
- (c) Cooperative personnel will be given access to the load management equipment for maintenance and inspection purposes.
- (d) A monthly credit will be paid during the billing months of June, July, August and September when energy usage is 400 kWh or higher.
- (e) Necessary load management equipment will be installed and maintained by a representative of the Cooperative.

Type of Service

Single-phase central air conditioners, 60 hertz, at available secondary voltages up to 240 volts.
