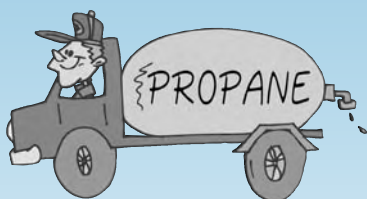

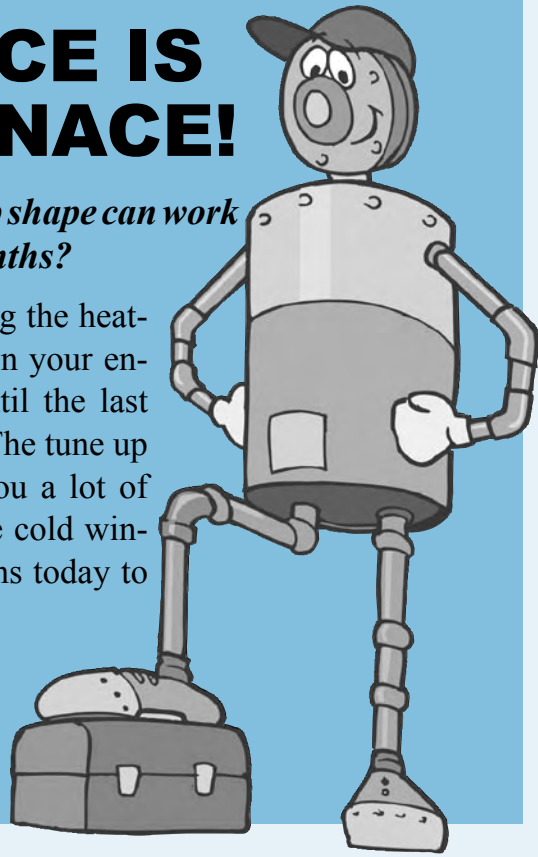

# MINIMUM USAGE REQUIREMENTS

These LP gas usage requirements became effective November 2006. Always be sure that you check with Energy Connections for current program details since changes may be made at any time.

## ANNUAL LEASE FEES

120 Tank	\$50.00
250 Tank	\$75.00
325 Tank	\$90.00
500 Tank	\$100.00
1,000 Tank	\$200.00

## MINIMUM USAGE

120 Tank	170 gallons
250 Tank	340 gallons
325 Tank	430 gallons
500 Tank	690 gallons
1,000 Tank	1,260 gallons

Lease fee prorated to actual annual gallons purchased, i.e., buy 50% of minimum - pay 50% of lease fee.

A yearly fee will be assessed if minimum usage requirements are not met.

Underground tanks are available for sale; Customer is responsible for excavating costs; additional charges for regulators, anodes, fittings, piping, etc.

## WILL CALL PROGRAM

- 5 Business days notice
- After hour emergency delivery - \$100; and \$25 out of gas leak check charge on all empty tanks
- If delivery is needed for same day, an after hour delivery charge will be applied.  
**Minimum delivery - 250 gallons for 500 gallon tank; 400 gallons for 1,000 gallon leased tank. Complete fill required for 325 gallon or smaller tanks**
- Cash discount of 3 cents per gallon for 250 or more gallons if paid within 3 business days of delivery
- All empty tanks are subject to a \$25 leak check charge. Insurance regulations require leak checks for safety reasons
- To avoid costly out of gas pressure checks and delivery charges, help us help you save money - sign up for our Automatic Delivery Program
- **Warning - One of the biggest causes of propane accidents is caused by allowing propane tanks to run out of propane.** Insurance companies require a leak check of the system before it can be turned on - for the safety of you and your family

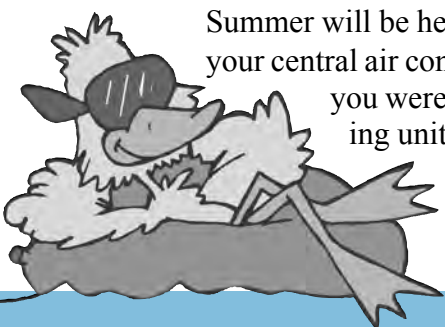
## KEEP ACCOUNT CURRENT

Please note that in order to receive propane, all accounts must be kept current whether on automatic delivery or will call delivery. All past due accounts are subject to the 5 business days notice following payment received on account. If there must be an after hour emergency or same day delivery and Energy Connections is not in your area, a trip charge of \$100 will be applied. All empty tanks are subject to a \$25 out of gas leak check charge. All charges are subject to change without notice.

Just making a few simple changes around your home or business can help make big changes in your energy bill this summer and all year round.

- Get your furnace tuned up! Summer is a perfect time to get your furnace tuned up. A tune up now can save you money and inconvenience next winter.

- Clean filters increase efficiency of your furnace. Cleaning them on a monthly basis helps.

- Fill your clothes washers, clothes dryers and dish washers. Don't run them on less than full loads.

- Use cold water in your clothes washer.

- Turn the heat down – reduce the thermostat on your water heater from the standard 120 degrees to 115 degrees. You could save more than 10% on your water heating.
