The undersigned (the Applicant, whether one or more) hereby applies for membership in Eau Claire Energy Cooperative (ECEC). The Applicant agrees to the following conditions of membership in ECEC:

1. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by provisions of ECEC's Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws, and such rules and regulations as may from time to time be adopted by ECEC. It is understood that all amounts paid by Applicant in excess of ECEC's operating costs and expenses are furnished as capital, subject to the bylaws.
2. The Applicant consents and agrees to pay such late charges, fees, and interest in such manner as the board of directors may specify on any past due accounts, and understands that member's debts to ECEC may be set off against any sums due member or member's successors from ECEC.
3. The Applicant, by becoming a member, assumes neither personal liability nor responsibility for any of ECEC's debts or liabilities, and it is expressly understood that under the bylaws, members' private property is exempt from execution for any such debts or liabilities.
4. The Applicant warrants that the information on this form is true and correct and authorizes ECEC to investigate Applicant's credit record and references. Applicant's utility credit history will be reviewed and a deposit may be required. If the energy bills are paid on time for full 12-months, the deposit (including any interest accrued) will be fully refunded.
5. By Signing the applicant believes they are financially able to meet any commitments they make and agrees to pay ECEC charges according to ECEC terms. All charges are due and payable the 20th of the month following date of invoice, unless specified otherwise. A 1.0% late fee shall be assessed on any outstanding balance after the 25th of the month.

If Applicant's premises are in ECEC's service area, Applicant agrees to purchase electric energy from ECEC upon the following terms and conditions:

6. The Applicant will, when electric energy becomes available, purchase from ECEC all electric energy used on Applicant's premises, except as otherwise permitted by ECEC, and will pay for such energy (including all minimum, standby, and facility charges) monthly or annually at rates to be determined from time to time by the board of directors.
7. The Applicant's premises shall be wired in compliance with the Wisconsin State Electrical Code. ECEC reserves the right at its option to terminate electric service if in its opinion the condition of the wiring facilities is hazardous.
8. The Applicant will grant to ECEC, without charge, such reasonable right-of-way easements over land owned by the undersigned as it may require for the construction, operation and maintenance of its lines and those of its licensees, as the same may be used for the transmission of electricity, gas, other forms of energy, or communications signals of any kind.
9. The Cooperative shall not be responsible because of service interruptions or variations in service resulting from acts of God, or public enemies, accidents, strikes, riots, wars, repairs, orders of Court, or other acts reasonably beyond the control of the Cooperative. It shall not be liable for damages directly or consequential, resulting from such interruption or failure.
10. The Cooperative, or any other utility, cannot provide electric service without interruption indefinitely. It is beyond the control of Eau Claire Energy Cooperative to completely eliminate interruptions in electric service. The member(s) may consider adding special protective equipment that will ensure a constant and regulated power supply to avoid damage to property. The Cooperative will endeavor to furnish continuous service but will not guarantee uninterrupted service. Should the member(s) suffer damage to personal property due to the factors beyond the Cooperative's control, the Cooperative is not legally liable for this damage.
 - a. In case the member required three-phase service, the installation and maintenance of adequate running overcurrent protective devices to protect against single-phase conditions and phase reversal are variable, and their installations and maintenance are the responsibility of the member.
11. Whenever there is a person at the service location whose health or safety may be threatened by an interruption in service because of infirmities of aging, developmental or mental disabilities, the use of life support systems, or like infirmities incurred at any age, or the frailties associated with being very young, please note that the Cooperative will make every effort to make service reliable. However, it is beyond the control of Eau Claire Energy Cooperative to completely eliminate interruptions in electric service. Please be advised to take the necessary precautions and have backups in place to sustain the health and safety of such individuals.
12. The member(s) will note and understand that such circumstances, as noted above, do not guarantee electric service without payment. The member(s) will understand that even in such circumstances as whose health or safety may be threatened by an interruption in service because of infirmities of aging, developmental or mental disabilities, the use of life support systems, or like infirmities incurred at any age, or the frailties associated with being very young, they are responsible for the billing of their services and be advised to have the necessary precautions and backups in place to sustain their health and safety.

The acceptance of this Applicant by ECEC shall constitute an agreement between the Applicant and ECEC, and the contract for electric service shall continue in force until canceled.
