

**EAU CLAIRE ENERGY COOPERATIVE  
RATE POLICY**

**Policy Number:** 800

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**– Interruptible –**  
**Subject:** Rate Schedule N – Irrigation and Off-Peak Low Temperature Crop-Drying

**Effective:** January 1, 2022

**A. Availability**

Available under established rules and regulations for service to irrigation and off-peak low temperature crop drying. Determination of feasibility and availability shall be made by the Cooperative for each request for electric power supply to loads in the Cooperative's service area. A contract will be required for each such service, which establishes conditions of service. **All loads must operate off-peak, by having full load connected to, and interrupted by, the Cooperative's load management system.**

**B. Type of Service**

Single-phase or multiphase, 60 hertz, at available secondary voltages or a combination of three-phase and single-phase through one meter. Motors shall have a locked-rotor indicating code letter of A through C.

**C. Rate**

The monthly sum of:

Monthly Service Charge

Single – Phase .....	\$34.00 per month
Three – Phase .....	\$51.00 per month

Energy Charge

All kWh used at .....	\$0.10000 per kWh
Power Cost Adjustment .....	Schedule PCA per kWh
Minimum Monthly Charge .....	Monthly Service Charge

**D. Equipment**

The Cooperative will furnish standard service transformers and metering. All other line extension costs will be paid for by the customer and the estimated cost paid to the Cooperative in advance of construction. Transformers for non-standard service will be paid for by the consumer.

**E. Taxes**

Wisconsin Sales Tax and Local Tax additional where applicable.

**F. Power Cost Adjustment**

A power cost adjustment will be included in all monthly billing as defined by ECEC's current rate schedule PCA.

**G. Terms of Payment**

- i. All meters are read monthly by the automated meter reading system or by the Cooperative's personnel. Payment is due when the bill is received. In no circumstances will the cumulative

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time before notice of disconnection be less than 20 days after the date of issuance of the bill and an account may be deemed delinquent for the purpose of disconnection after such period has elapsed. A late payment of 1% per month will be added to utility bills not paid and credited prior to the next monthly billing.

- ii. The service may be disconnected and reconnected once per calendar year without charge. Additional disconnects and reconnects will be billed at the Cooperative's published reconnect rate.
