A. Availability

Available under established rules and regulations for service to irrigation and off-peak low temperature crop drying. Determination of feasibility and availability shall be made by the Cooperative for each request for electric power supply to loads in the Cooperative's service area. A contract will be required for each such service, which establishes conditions of service. All loads must operate off-peak, by having full load connected to, and interrupted by, the Cooperative's load management system.

B. Type of Service

Single-phase or multiphase, 60 hertz, at available secondary voltages or a combination of three-phase and single-phase through one meter. Motors shall have a locked-rotor indicating code letter of A through C.

C. Rate

The monthly sum of:

D. Equipment

The Cooperative will furnish standard service transformers and metering. All other line extension costs will be paid for by the customer and the estimated cost paid to the Cooperative in advance of construction. Transformers for non-standard service will be paid for by the consumer.

E. Taxes

F. Power Cost Adjustment

A power cost adjustment will be included in all monthly billing as defined by the Cooperative's current rate schedule PCA.

G. Terms of Payment
