FREE Electric Vehicle Charging

Is an Electric Vehicle in your future?

Transitioning to an Electric Vehicle can be a big decision. Eau Claire Energy Cooperative wants to help by offering programs that allow you to keep your Electric Vehicle (EV) charged and ready to go when you are. At the same time, it's important to keep energy costs affordable for your family.

Our Free In-Home Charger and FreEV programs can help you get set for EV charging and cut energy costs on your monthly bills.

Choose one of two programs to fit your lifestyle

Free In-Home Charger

- ECEC member consumers receive a \$500 rebate towards an in-home Level II (fast) charger when connected to a load control device.
- Charger must be connected to a load control receiver, controlled 2:00PM-9PM Mon-Fri.

Special FreEV Pilot Program limited 25 members

- This one does not involve any equipment installed in your home. When charging your EV during off-peak hours the electricity will be FREE; up to 400 kWh.
- Available to ECEC members who own an electric vehicle and are not currently utilizing Distributed Generation, including MemberSolar. This program is currently limited to the first 25 member who participate.
- Energy for the remainder of the day, or in excess of the 400 kWh during off-peak will be charged \$0.148 per kWh during the months of June-September and \$0.132 per kWh all other months.

FreEV Questions and Answers:

1. What kind of vehicles qualify?

- a. Passenger automobiles that are 100% electric and legally permitted for public roads. Motorcycles, ATVs, golf carts, etc. will not qualify.
- b. Commercial fleet vehicles are not eligible. This pilot program is only available for residential, farm or small commercial members.

2. Does a Hybrid vehicle qualify?

No. In order to qualify, the vehicle must be 100% electric. Hybrids as well as Plug-In Hybrids do not qualify.

3. What if I sell my EV?

Notify ECEC as soon as you sell your vehicle so we can adjust your rate accordingly.

4. If I don't use 400 kWh during the FREE period, would the balance carry over?

No. If you do not use the 400 kWh 10:00PM-6:00AM in a billing period, the remainder would not be carried to the next month. The maximum FREE kWh is 400 for any billing period.

5. How long will the pilot program run?

The program ends May 1, 2022.

6. Can I opt out of the program?

Yes, you can opt out anytime.

7. How do I learn more?
