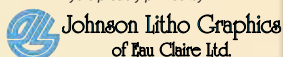

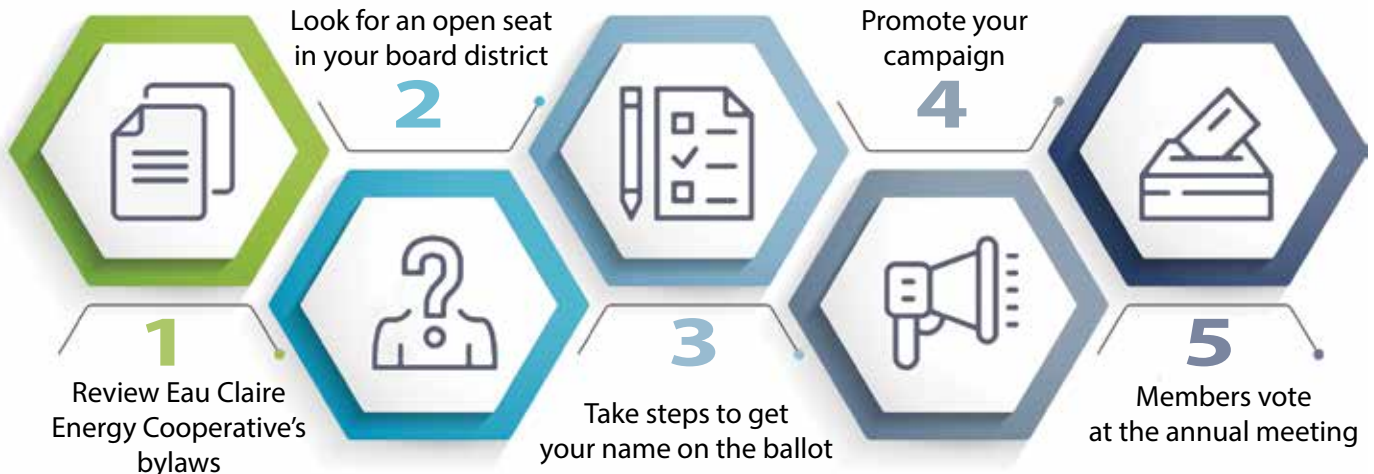

### District 7

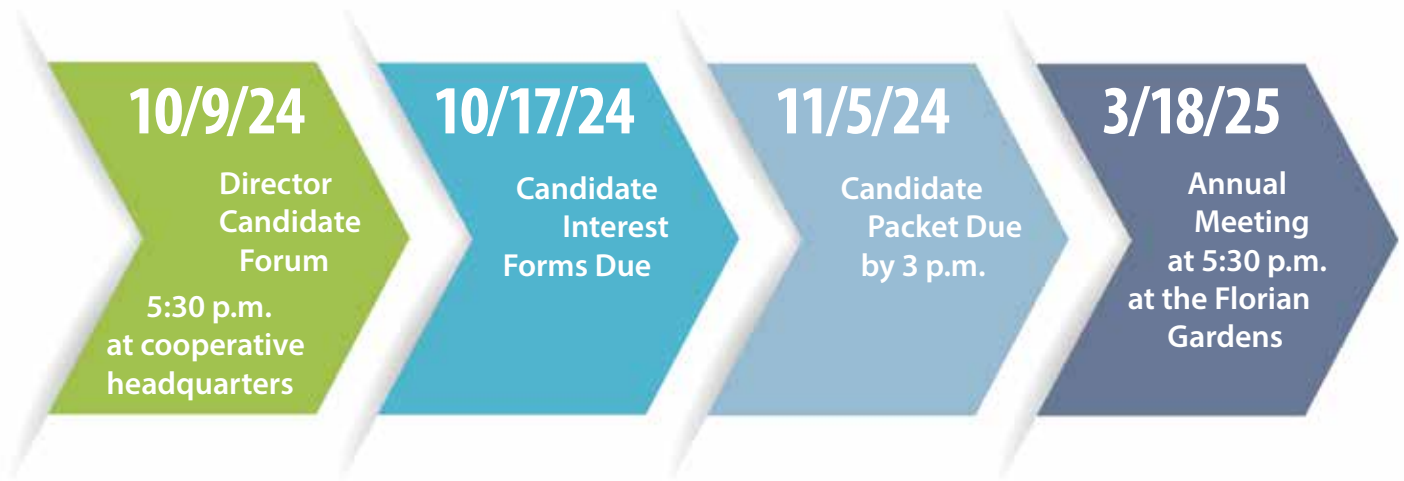

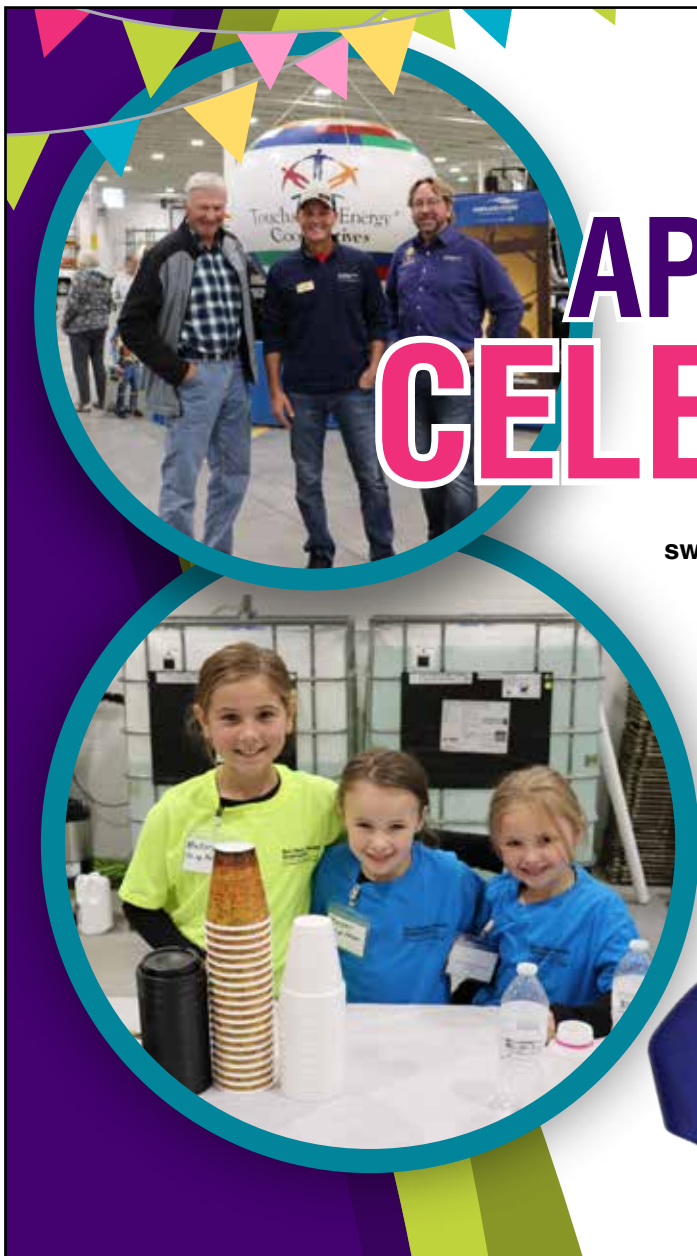
